



What types of lights are Accepted?

Fluorescent Light Tubes (straight or curved), Compact Fluorescent Lights (CFLs) and High Intensity Discharge Lights (HIDs).

How many lights can I recycle?

Recycle up to **10 lights** per day at no charge.

Where can I drop off my lights?

Why recycle?

Washington State law makes it illegal to throw away mercury-containing lights in the garbage.



LightRecycle Washington is funded by an Environmental Handling Charge (EHC). An EHC of \$0.25 per light will be added to all mercury-containing lights sold at retail in Washington State.
